COKE FILTRATION TOWER

SECTION 00100 – INVITATION TO BID

The Town of Carolina Beach is currently seeking bids for the construction of a Coke Filtration Tower.

This is a single prime contract and all prospective bidders must possess the appropriate license and resources to complete the project in its entirety. Each bidder must show evidence it is an appropriately licensed contractor under Chapter 87 of the North Carolina General Statutes. All work shall be completed within 30 days from Notice to Proceed.

The Town of Carolina Beach is seeking contractors to remove and dispose of an existing Coke Filtration Tower from the raw water ground storage tank located at the Town's facility at 306 Cape Fear Blvd and then construct a new Coke Filtration Tower in place. Both the existing structure and proposed structure are wood framed. Work is expected to be limited to framing and installation of wooden structures, which hold filter media for pre-treatment of raw water. Contractors are strongly encouraged to visit the site and review the existing conditions.

All Document Clarification Requests during bidding shall be received in writing, using Specification Section 00215 Appendix A - Document Clarification Request Form, at least seven days prior to the bid opening. Refer to Specification Section 00215 - Document Clarification Request, which specifies administrative and procedural requirements for disposition of Document Clarification Request (DCR's) during the Bidding Phase.

Sealed Bids will be submitted to and received by The Town of Carolina Beach, Attn: Gil DuBois, Director of Operations, 1121 N. Lake Park Boulevard, Carolina Beach, NC 28428. The bids shall be marked "Carolina Beach Coke Filtration Tower Project" and shall be received until 3:00 PM, on March 10, 2017. All bids will be publicly read at 3:05 PM, on March 10, 2017, in the Town of Carolina Beach Council Chambers, located at 1121 N. Lake Park Boulevard, Town of Carolina Beach 28428. No electronic or faxed submittals of bids will be accepted.

The Bid Documents shall be submitted in total. Complete bids shall include attached supplemental documentation as required. The Town of Carolina Beach reserves the right to reject any and all bids. The Town of Carolina Beach will negotiate a final contract with the successful bidder.
