--YOUR SEWER--

Did you know...most sanitary sewer backups occur between your home and the town's sewer main? You can help prevent a costly and unsanitary overflow by following a few simple steps:

DO ...

-  **Scrape excess cooled grease in a container and dispose of it in the garbage**
-  **Place food scraps in waste containers or garbage bags for disposal with solid wastes; promote use of scraping ware prior to washing**
-  **Place a waste basket in the bathroom to dispose of solid wastes; disposable diapers, condoms and personal hygiene products do not belong in the sewer system**
-  **Promote the concept of the "3R's": Reduce, Reuse, Recycle**

DO NOT...

-  **Pour Fats, Oils or Grease from cooking down the drain or in garbage disposal**
-  **Use the toilet as a waste basket**
-  **Use the sewer as a means of disposing of food scraps**
