

BID NOTICE TO ALL QUALIFIED CONTRACTORS

Corunna Dam Removal and Heritage Park Improvements

City of Corunna 402 N. Shiawassee Street, Corunna, MI 48817

The City of Corunna is inviting all qualified contractors to attend a mandatory pre-bid meeting for construction to remove Corunna Dam and improve recreation features within Heritage Park. Work will include removal of the dam, earthwork and restoration of the Shiawassee River channel and banks adjacent to the dam, placement of wood structures for bank stabilization, installation of stone grade control structures within the river, and planting of native vegetation to stabilize and enhance the shoreline enhanced by the dam removal. Recreation improvements surrounding the dam removal will include a parking lot, sidewalk, fishing platform adjacent to Heritage Park, and parking improvements, temporary restroom, and kayak launch installation at the end of Brady Street upstream from the dam. GEI Consultants of Michigan, P.C. is the engineer of record.

Project construction will commence following the July 4th holiday and conclude November 14, 2019. Design and construction funding is provided by the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service Fish Passage Program, Saginaw Bay Watershed Initiative Network, Michigan Department of Natural Resource's Dam Management Program, and the Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund.

Interested and qualified contractors are invited to attend a MANDATORY pre-bid meeting at Corunna City Hall on Thursday, April 11, 2019 at 1:30 PM. Corunna City Hall is located at 402 North Shiawassee Street, Corunna, MI 48817.
