CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY NOTICE (Project Progress)

Activity Type: Pavement and Curb Sawing

Dear Resident,

John Neri Construction will begin saw cutting pavement and curb **tomorrow, April 4, 2018**. All areas marked with pink paint will be removed and replaced. Removal crews will follow based on the schedule listed below (weather permitting). The contractor has submitted the following schedule which will be adjusted as the project progresses:

North St – Adams St to West end of street
Hickory St – Stough St to Adams St
Madison St – Bonnie Brae to Glendale
Madison St – Warren Ct to Morris Lane
Morris Lane
Warren Court
Wedgewood Court

Some driveway curbs will be replaced, which will require the removal and replacement of a portion of your driveway apron. Access to these driveways will be restored at the end of each day with stone ramps. NOT all driveways are affected. Once the new driveway curb is poured, access will be prohibited for five (5) to seven (7) days. Please use alternate side streets for daily and overnight parking during the driveway curb construction. Please plan accordingly.

Daily operations will begin at 7:00 AM and should be completed by 4:00 PM. Driveway access will be affected for areas with construction activity. To avoid conflicts with construction operations, please have your vehicles out of the driveway prior to 7:00 AM. This portion of the project is scheduled for completion by late May 2018.

Residents should avoid the construction zones as much as possible. Daily parking is available on side streets. If travel through the work zone is necessary, please use extreme caution.
