

**AVISTON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT
NOTICE OF ELECTION**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the Consolidated Election to be held on Tuesday, the 4TH day of April, 2017, the following proposition will be submitted to the legal voters of Aviston Elementary School District No. 21, Clinton and Madison Counties, Illinois:

Shall the maximum annual tax rate for educational purposes of Aviston Elementary School District No. 21, Clinton and Madison Counties, Illinois, be increased and established at 1.27 percent upon all the taxable property of said School District at the value, as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue, instead of .92 percent, the present maximum rate otherwise applicable to the next taxes to be extended for said purpose?

- a. The approximate amount of taxes extendible for educational purposes under the maximum rate now in force in said School District is the sum of \$467,022.
- b. The approximate amount of taxes extendible for educational purposes under the proposed increased rate is the sum of \$644,693.
- c. The total dollar amount of the most recently approved annual budget of said School District is the sum of \$2,900,460; the total dollar amount of said annual budget, if increased by the amount of additional tax which may be levied if the proposition is approved, is the sum of \$3,078,131; the percentage of increase in the total dollar amount of the most recently approved annual budget of said School District if such total dollar amount were increased by the amount of additional tax which may be levied if the proposition is approved, is 6.13 percent.
- d. The percentage increase between the maximum rate at which such taxes for educational purposes may be levied if the proposition is approved and the annual rate at which such taxes for educational purposes is currently levied is 38.0 percent.

The polls at the election will open at 6:00 o'clock A.M. and continue to be until 7:00 o'clock P.M. of that day.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the election to be held on Tuesday, April 4, 2017, the following proposition will be submitted to the legal voters of Madison County:

PROPOSITION E

Shall the maximum annual tax rate for educational purposes for Edwardsville Community Unit School District No. 7, Madison County, Illinois, be increased and established at 2.70 percent upon all the taxable property of said School District at the value, as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue, instead of 2.15 percent, the present maximum rate otherwise applicable to the next taxes to be extended for said purposes?

- (a) The approximate amount of taxes extendible for educational purposes under the maximum rate now in force in said School District is \$27,083,835.11.
- (b) The approximate amount of taxes extendible for educational purposes under the proposed increased rate is \$34,012,258.05.
- (c) The total dollar amount of the most recently approved annual budget of said School District is the sum of \$74,318,057.00; the total dollar amount of said annual budget , if increased by the amount of additional tax which may be levied if the proposition is approved, is the sum of \$81,246,479.94; the percentage of increase in the total dollar amount of the most recently approved annual budget of said School District if such total dollar amount were increased by the amount of additional tax which may be levied if the proposition is approved is 9.32 percent.
- (d) The percentage of increase between the maximum rate at which such taxes for educational purposes may be levied if the proposition is approved and the annual rate at which such taxes for educational purposes is currently levied is 25.58 percent.
