## ***Scholarship Pre-Application***

*The Charlie Brown Emergency Services Foundation was founded in 2010 after the death of Corporal Charlie Brown. Charlie Brown was a narcotics officer with the Martin County Sheriff's Office when he was shot and killed in the line of duty on December 8, 2009. The Charlie Brown Emergency Services Foundation was formed in his memory.*

*The Charlie Brown Emergency Services Scholarship is intended to provide financial support to upcoming college freshman (college students) from Martin County that are entering an emergency services field. Applicants must be planning to attend an accredited college / university that will lead to an undergraduate degree in a field of study designed to prepare students for careers related to emergency service (i.e. Law Enforcement, Fire / EMS, Nursing, etc.). This is a one time award that will be granted only to applicants who provide documentation that they are enrolled in a college / university and formally pledge that they intend to be involved in an emergency services related field.*

### **Criteria**

1. This scholarship will be awarded based on the following criteria: academic record, community service, career aspirations, and overall impression of the applicant.
2. Students must submit a pre-application and all required information by March 20, 2020. Recipients will be notified if they are selected to participate in Phase II by phone call or letter no later than April 03, 2020. Those not selected to move forward in the process will not receive any further correspondence from the scholarship committee.

### **Application Process**

The application process consists of three phases:

Phase I	Pre-application
Phase II	Application / Essay
Phase III	Interview

### **Pre-Application**

The applicant must complete a pre-application process which includes the submission of student biographical information, high school transcripts, and three (3) letters of reference. Applicant must carry a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 which must be documented on an official transcript. References should include a minimum of one teacher who can attest to the student's performance in the classroom and one individual outside the formal educational setting which can attest to the applicant's character. All letters of reference and the transcript(s) must be sealed in an envelope with the author's initials across the seal.
