Hinsdale, IL –

In August 2019, the Village of Hinsdale filed a motion in DuPage County Court against Trinity Sober Living (“Trinity”) for, among other things, injunctive relief. The Village asked the Court to order that all commercial use of 111 N. Grant (the “Property”) immediately cease and to enjoin Trinity from using the Property, which is in a single-family zoning district, for any commercial use. Additionally, the Village requested that the Court enjoin the Property Owner from violating the occupancy restrictions outlined in the Village Zoning Code applicable to R-4 Districts.

On Friday, February 7, 2020, Judge Diamond issued a preliminary injunction in the case against Trinity.

Under the Court’s order, only residents residing at the Property as of February 7, 2020 may remain on the Property, and no new residents shall be permitted to move into the Property until further order by the Court.

The Village is pleased that Judge Diamond ruled in favor of the Village on this preliminary matter, avoids intensification of the use of the Property during the pendency of the on-going litigation between the Village and Trinity.

The Village is committed to enforcing its Zoning Code in an even-handed manner to preserve the character of our residential neighborhoods and to protect residents’ property values.

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
