

DISASTER RECOVERY NEXT STEPS: APPEAL TO FEMA DETERMINATION LETTER




If you are a disaster survivor who has received a denial letter for FEMA financial assistance and would like to make an appeal, please take one or more of the following steps.

Please Note: Appeals must be made within 60 days of the time the FEMA determination letter was received.



Call FEMA: 1-800-621-3362

A FEMA representative will explain why you received a denial letter. Many times the decision was based on a lack of complete information and the FEMA representative will let you know what additional documentation is needed.
